that we Chunesa Anne Duke George W Tucker  
Reading Banuick are held and firmly bound  
unto William C Perry Judge of Bibb County  
Court for the time being and his Successors  
in office in the penal sum of thirteen  
hundred & fifty Dollars for the true and  
faithful payment of which well and  
truly to be made we bind our selves  
and each of us our heirs Executors and  
administrators Jointly severly and finally  
by these presents sealed with our seals  
and dated this 4th day of January  
1847

The condition of the above obligation  
is such that whereas the above bound  
Chunesa Anne Duke has been appointed Guardian  
of the person and Estate of Littleton Crowder  
-field Duke  
Minor heir of Littleton Duke Deceased  
now if the said Chunesa Anne Duke shall  
well and truly perform all the duties  
which are or may be by Law Required of  
her as such guardian then the above  
obligation to be void Else to Remain  
in full force and effect in Law

firmly bound by these presents sealed  
with our Seals and dated this the  
4th Day of January AD 1827

Guardian of the person and estate of  
Mary Caroline Duke minor heir of  
Littleton Duke deceased now if the  
said Chinese Ann Duke shall well and

as such Guardian then the above  
obligation to be void Else Remain  
in full force and effect in Law
